



If you feel you have damages as a result of the March 2012 data breach at the Department of Health, the Governmental Immunity Act, [Utah Code Ann. 63G-7-401 et seq.](#) requires that for state claims you must file a claim within one year of the date of the accident. The Notice of Claim must be postmarked within one year of your accident, otherwise your claim may be barred.

The Notice of Claim should be sent to:

The Governmental Immunity Act requires that the Notice of Claim outline the facts of the accident, injuries sustained, damages associated with the accident, etc. Please include a copy of the letter you received from the Department of Health indicating your data was part of the breach and any other documentation that substantiates your damages. The Notice of Claim should be signed by you.

This information does not constitute a waiver of any of the provisions or requirements of the Governmental Immunity Act, Utah Code Ann. 63G-7-401 et seq., nor does it confirm or verify the sufficiency of the claimant's notice of claim as required by that Act.
