Someone stole information from Utah Medicaid on March 30.

We don't know if your information was stolen.

You need to protect yourself and your family now by making sure no one is using your information.

To help you, the state will pay a company to watch your credit report for you. They will let you know if it looks like anyone is using your information. If someone is using your information, a person who works for the company will work with you to fix it. The company's name is Experian ProtectMyID.

This is what you should do **before July 31, 2011**:

- Call 877-371-7902 to sign up. Or go to www.protectmyid.com/redeem and sign up online.
- This is the number you will need when you call [code].
