



Gap in Coverage Without the Medicaid Expansion

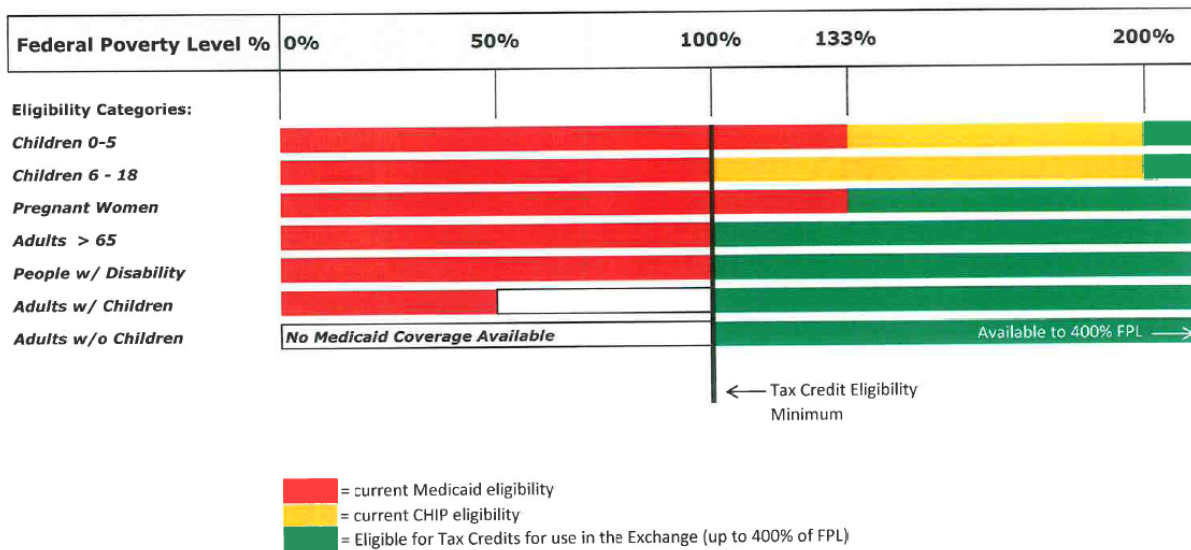

The gap in health care coverage without the Medicaid expansion is inefficient and inhumane because it leaves the poorest of the poor without affordable insurance options.

The white areas below indicate no coverage options for:

- parents living in households with incomes above 44% Federal Poverty Line (FPL), or \$8,400 for a family of 3; OR
- childless adults living in households with incomes from 0 to 100% FPL, or \$0 to \$19,090 for a family of 3.
