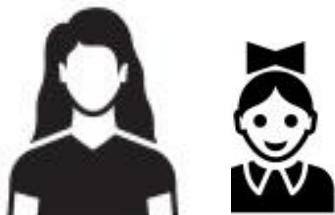


WHAT'S WRONG WITH THIS STORY?



Melissa is a 24-year old Utah mom who works, pays taxes, and earns \$7,000 a year.



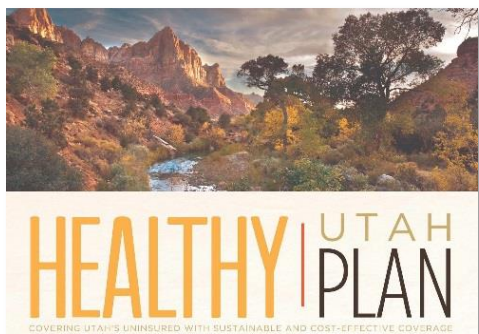
Melissa and her daughter receive health insurance through Utah Medicaid.
