**WHO:** Implementation Oversight Workgroup of the Legislature's Health System Reform Task Force

**AGENDA:** The workgroup will cover as many of these items as time permits.

1. **UPDATE ON UTAH HEALTH EXCHANGE**

The workgroup will receive an update on the status of full small group participation in the Exchange (registered employers, eligible employees, number and type of plans, etc.). The workgroup will also review timelines for the initial launch and ongoing enrollment and review the requirement for employers to submit employee census information prior to the plan selection process.

2. **PORTABLE RISK FACTOR**

Legislation enacted in 2010 provided that if an employer's insurer outside the defined contribution arrangement market (DCAM) is also participating in the DCAM, the employer must be allowed to enter the DCAM for either a defined contribution plan or a defined benefit plan with the same risk factor (or lower) that the employer would have if renewing with the insurer outside the DCAM (the employer is not required to select the same insurer or plan used outside the DCAM). The workgroup will consider whether this provision needs to be amended to accomplish the intent of the Legislature.

3. **NAIC UPDATE**

The workgroup will be briefed on the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act issues the National Association of Insurance Commissioners is responding to and the Utah Insurance Department's role in NAIC's work.

4. **CALL CENTER**

The workgroup will review issues related to the Utah Health Exchange call center.

5. **EXCHANGE GOVERNANCE**

The workgroup will discuss rulemaking authority and other governance issues related to the operation of the Utah Health Exchange.
