




























































What the ACA does for Medicare

- Closes the "donut hole" in Medicare prescription drug coverage by 2020
- Adds annual "wellness visits" plus free screenings for diabetes and cancer
- No cuts to benefits or changes guaranteed by Medicare
- Puts Medicare on a more solid financial footing



What is the Medicare donut hole? • Before the ACA, seniors paid 100% of drug costs while in the "Donut Hole" between Initial Coverage and Catastrophic Coverage What do seniors pay in 2016 for prescription drugs? 100% \$3,310 \$360 \$4,850 2016 25% 5% **Deductible** Initial **Donut hole** Catastrophic In 2016, seniors pay 45%-58% of drug costs in the Donut Hole
