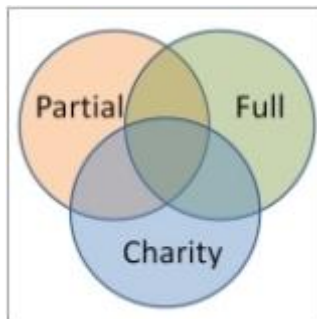
Navigator Grants Awarded

Last Thursday the federal Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) [awarded 120 grants totaling \\$67 million](#) to over 100 organizations poised to operate navigator programs across the country. The [Utah Health Policy Project](#) (UHPP), and its lead partners—the [Association for Utah Community Health](#) (AUCH) and [United Way 2-1-1](#)—were selected as the nonprofit, community-based navigator in Utah with an award of [\\$406,788](#).
