

 70% on employer-based health insurance

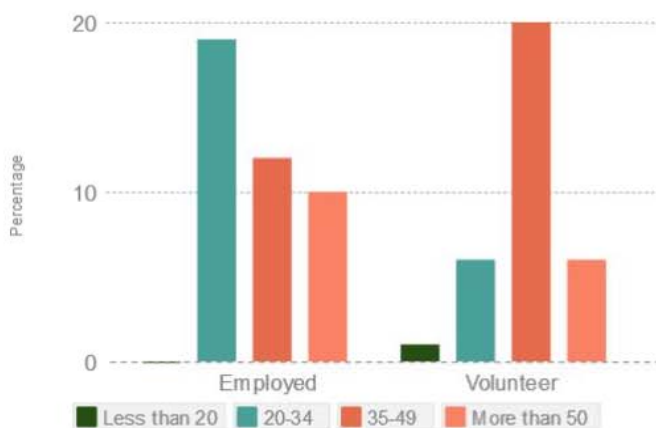

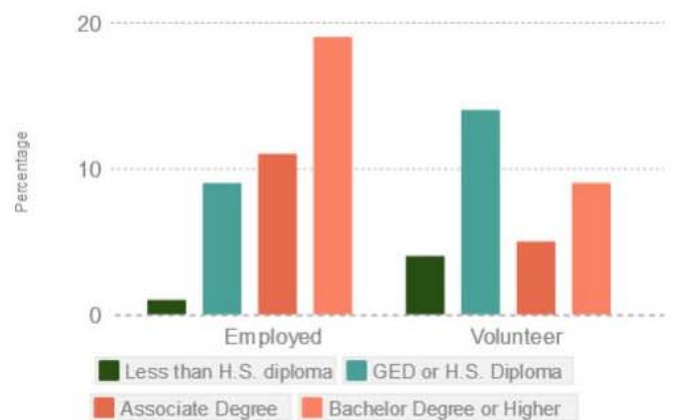

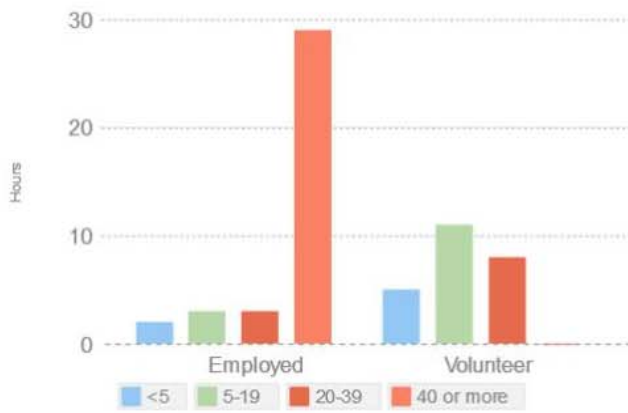

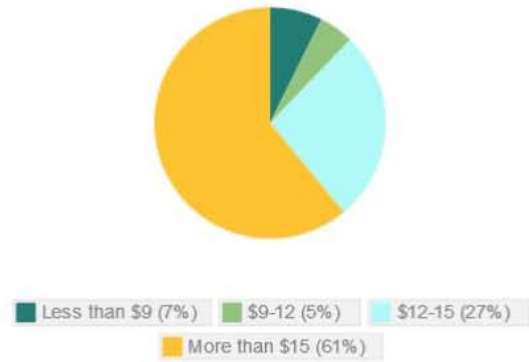
Education



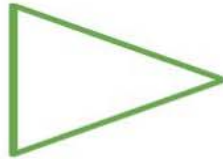
Hours worked or volunteered



Employed CHWs Hourly Pay

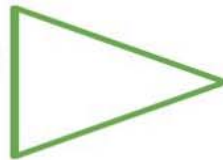


Top 3 types of organizations CHWs work in



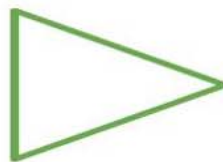
1. Non-profits (n=47)

3. Partner agency(ies) training (n=26)

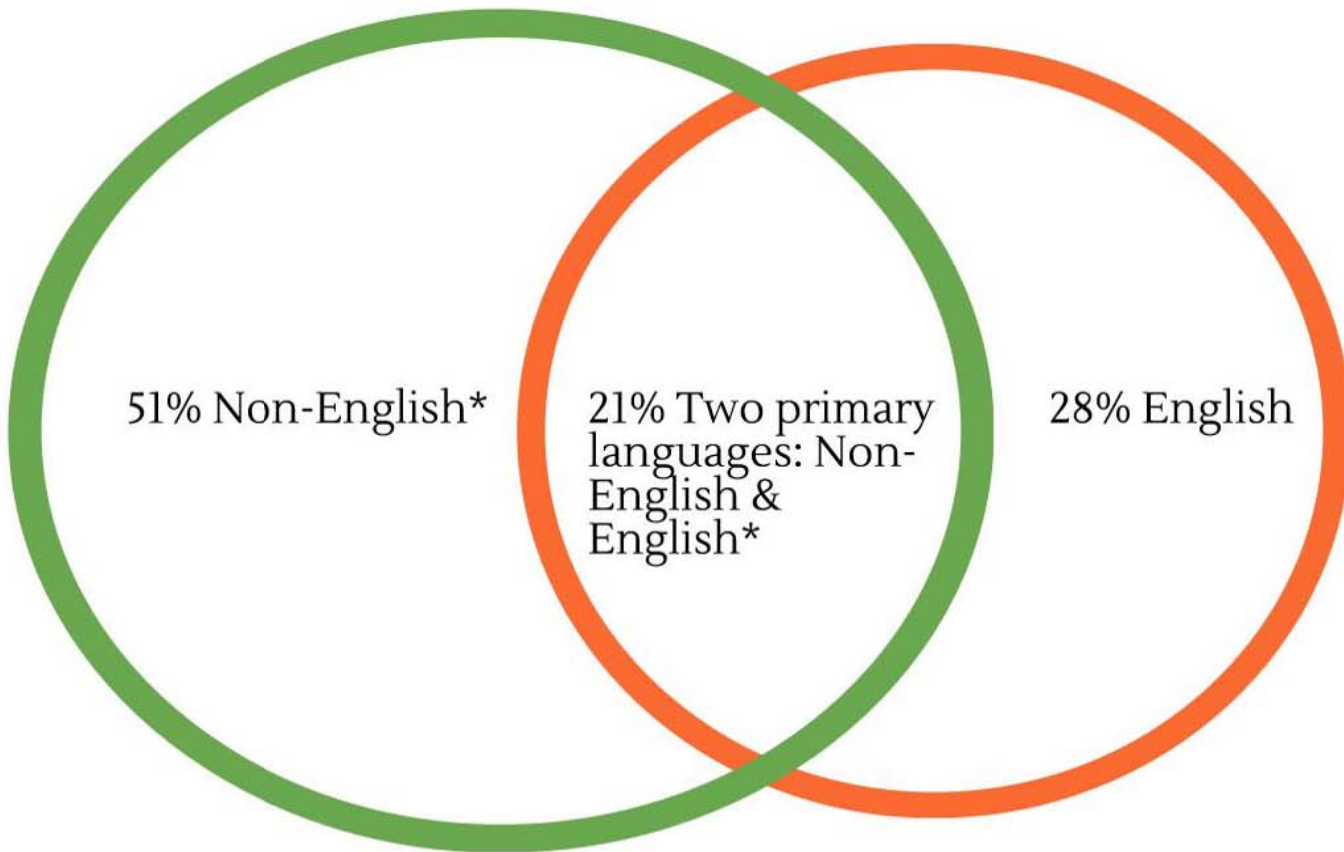
Top 4 health areas*

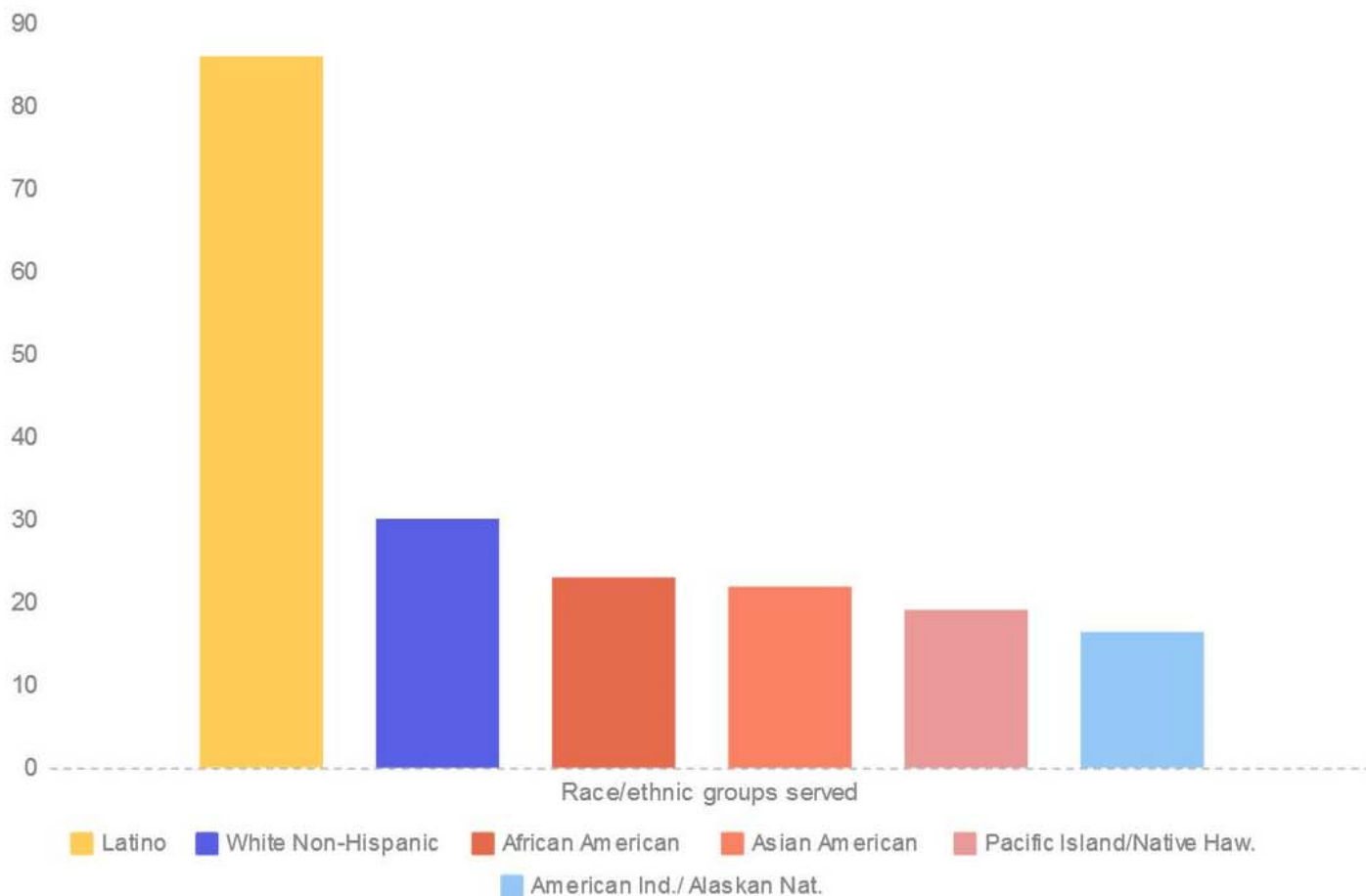
